Safety Regulations

- Keep the appliance and electrical plug away from that the appliance should fall into water, immethe appliance checked by a certified technician. Not following these instructions could give rise to life-threatening situations.
- Never try to open the casing of the appliance your-
- Do not insert any objects in the casing of the appliance.
- Do not touch the plug with wet or damp hands.
- Regularly check the plug and cord for any damage. Should the plug or cord be damaged have it/them repaired by a certified repair company.
- Do not use the appliance after it has fallen or is damaged in any other way. Have it checked and repaired, if necessary, by a certified repair company.

- Make sure the cord does not come in contact with sharp or hot objects and keep it away from open fire. To pull the plug out of the socket, always pull on the plug and not on the cord.
- Make sure that no one can accidentally pull the cord (or extension cord) loose or trip over the cord.

 - Always remove the plug from the socket when filling or cleaning the appliance.

- Do not try to repair the appliance yourself. This This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

Special safety regulations


- Do not use the appliance to slice frozen food, meat Stop using the appliance as soon as the blade's that has not been deboned, fish or any non-food products.
- Though the appliance has built-in safety features, keep away from the blade and moving parts at all times.
- diameter has become thinner than 6 mm. Replace the blade.

Preparations before using for the first time

- parts are missing, contact your supplier.
- Remove all the packing material.
- Clean the appliance with lukewarm water and a soft cloth.
- Clean the blade. Be careful: the blade is very sharp.
- Check to make sure no parts are missing. If any Keep open a space of at least 10 cm around the appliance to allow for adequate ventilation.
 - Position the appliance in such a way that the plug is always accessible.
 - If the sharpening device is not attached, proceed as follows:



1. Top view of the appliance



2. Attach the sharpening module 3. Secure the sharpening device in such a way that the blade does not move between the wheels.

NOTE! The sharpening device is equipped with a safety switch. If the sharpening device is not properly attached, you will not be able to use the appliance.


Instructions for use



 - Position the blade sharpener in its support so Put the food product on the carriage and adjust the clamp to hold the product firmly in place. Make sure the product is positioned against the stop plate.

 - Turn the thickness dial back to "0".

How to Lock the slicer


1 To turn the knob in anti-clockwise direction



Continue to turn the knob until it is loosen COMPLETELY




Move the carriage to the proper position, the slicer will be locked automatically



How to Unlock the slicer

To turn the knob in clockwise direction to unlock the slicer. The knob should be turned COMPLETELY to tighten the carriage



Cleaning and maintenance

- Turn the slice thickness dial in counter clockwise direction to the "0" position,
- Always pull the plug from the socket before cleaning the appliance.
- or other liquids!
- water and a mild cleaning agent).
- Never use corrosive or abrasive cleaning agents.

Do not use sharp or pointed objects for cleaning. Do not use benzene or solvents! Clean with a damp cloth. Use washing-up liquid if needed, but never abrasive cleaning agents.

- Warning: Never submerge the appliance in water Clean the blade with alcohol. WARNING! The blade is extremely sharp.
- Use a damp cloth to clean surfaces (solution of If the food carriage stops sliding smoothly, lay the machine on its side. Clean the slide bar carefully and lubricate it with Vaseline



Problem

Problem	Possible cause	Solution	
Appliance does not slice well	Blunt blade	Sharpen blade	
	Dirty appliance	Clean the appliance	
Appliance stops slicing	Overheated motor	Let the machine cool off for an extended period. The motor's safety thermostat will reset itself automatically.	
Carriage does not slide	Dirty slide bar	Clean the slide bar and lubricate with Vaseline	
Blade stops when product is being cut	v-belt worn out or dirty	Replace or clean the v-belt	

When in doubt, always contact your supplier!

Sharpening the blade

Sharpen the blade when it becomes blunt. The blade is extremely resistant to wear. If used regularly and properly, it should only need to be sharpened once a year.

- Pull the plug from the wall socket.
- Turn the thickness dial to "0".
- Clean the blade.
- Unscrew the sharpener's locking knob.
- Lift the sharpener from the locking device and turn it 180°.
- Both sides of the blade should have 1 sharpening stone.
- Lower the sharpener until it slips back into the locking device.
- Fix the sharpener in place by tightening the locking knob.
- Switch on the appliance. The blade will start to turn.
- Use the button to press the tilted sharpening stone The appliance is ready for use.

- against the blade and keep it there for 2 minutes. The sharpening stone should turn along with the blade.
- Use the button to press the vertical sharpening stone briefly against the blade to remove burrs. The sharpening stone should turn along with the blade.
- Switch off the appliance and pull the plug from the wall socket.
- Unscrew the sharpener's locking knob and clean the sharpening stones with alcohol.
- Replace the sharpener in its original position on the appliance and tighten the locking knob to fix it in place. The blade must not extend between the sharpening stones.
- Clean the blade with alcohol, WARNING! The blade is extremely sharp.
- Push the plug in the wall socket.
